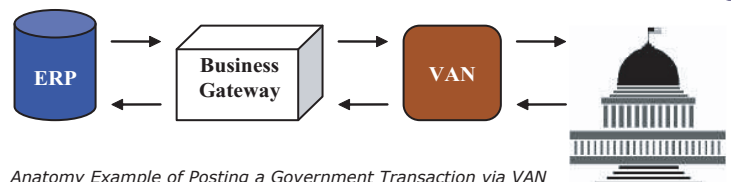

## Electronic Interaction with Government Agencies

From either a business or regulatory perspective, transacting with United States Government agencies requires pre-approved standards. Common Government Agency standards are supported by Business Gateway™ and are available in individual libraries. In addition to these standards, most Government Agencies, such as the Department of Defense, publish these standards in SEF (Standard Exchange Format). SEF guidelines can be imported directly into Business Gateway™ for immediate use, and require no further formatting or configuration. These formats are also continually being added to the Business Gateway™ EDI libraries by iomotion and can be easily added as needed.

## The Government Solution Anatomy

Unless otherwise approved by the agency, transactions are generally communicated via a VAN or Value Added Network (such as AT&T) for reliability and security. In a sample anatomy, Business Gateway would serve both the ERP or internal system and the VAN. Data would be pulled from the ERP system, or pushed via transactions and sent to the VAN, upon acknowledgement, the ERP system would then be notified and updated as needed.
